1 (3) by adding at the end the following: 2 "(2) The Commission may not grant such an application for the transfer of a permit described in subsection 3 4 (c) that proposes a change in the primary language in 5 which programming by a radio station described in that 6 subsection will be broadcast, unless the Commission sepa-7 rately certifies to the Committee on Commerce, Science, 8 and Transportation of the Senate and the Committee on 9 Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives that, in the judgment of the Commission, and in addition 10 11 to the requirements and prohibitions under section 310, 12 the programming of the radio station is not, and will not 13 become, subject to undue influence by a foreign government or a political party in power in a foreign country.". 14
